

Improved Pedestrian Access



Invite pedestrians arriving from Beaufort with a new sidewalk along Wilcox, and a treed promenade along the west side of the park.



Invite pedestrians to use the existing park paths with new signage and public art - and make the walk around and through the gazebo more inviting.



Make it more inviting for pedestrians to go along Port Augusta from Comox Avenue to the harbour - with: new signage, two new rest areas, a new softly-sloped path, and a treed promenade along the east side of the park



Improve pedestrian access along the east side of the east parking lot with a more generous sidewalk, gentler grade and improved traffic marking.



"The Village"

- 1) Two main paths along the waterfront - giving variety and many ways to experience the place.
- 2) Generous access for carts and delivery vehicles to the harbour.
- 3) A "Village Plaza", or square, south of the gazebo as a main focus for public events and for private contemplation.

Also, add a path making it easy for pedestrians to move east and west along the waterfront.
