



- ✓ Plastic packaging for toys, batteries etc. Separate plastic from paper backing
- ✓ Plastic pails less than 25L for laundry detergent etc.
- ✓ Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, chips, etc.
- ✓ Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.

PLASTIC BAGS AND OVERWRAP

- ✓ Bags for groceries, produce, dry bulk foods, frozen vegetables, water softener, salt, garden products, newspapers, etc.
- ✓ Overwrap for diapers, feminine hygiene products, paper towels, soft drink flats

RECYCLING TIPS

You can help ensure that more materials are recycled by following these steps:

- 1 Place your blue boxes side by side. Allow 1m (3ft) between your recycling containers and your garbage bin.
- 2 Empty and rinse containers.
- 3 Contain shredded paper inside a paper or CLEAR plastic bag before adding to your recycling bin.
- 4 Flatten cardboard and remove plastic wrap from cardboard flats. Staples and tape are okay. If cardboard is too large for recycling bin, flatten and cut to no larger than 30" (78 cm) by 30" (78 cm). Stack neatly and securely place beside or between recycling bins.

Hard and soft cover books

Paper towels, napkins and tissues

- ✗ Non-paper gift wrap, foil wrap
- ✗ Rubber bands, ribbons, bows
- ✗ Padded envelopes
- ✗ Bags and boxes with foil liners
- ✗ Plastic bags used to cover newspapers/flyers

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Exclude batteries; medical syringes; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words **DANGER**, **WARNING** or **POISON**, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.

NOT ACCEPTED

- ✗ Clothing, textiles and shoes
- ✗ Foam packaging
- ✗ Stand up pouches

- ✗ Food and yard waste
- ✗ Packaging labeled biodegradable or compostable
