To apply for the *Shaw Kindness Sticks* youth grant, students are encouraged to work with their classmates and school to submit their ideas online at shaw.ca/KindnessSticks. Students may submit their ideas until April 30. Once the submission has closed, a panel of expert judges will review the applications and award the grants in September 2018. The grants will be awarded to each school to implement the submitted idea in partnership with the student.
