



2021 MUNICIPAL BY-ELECTION

MAIL BALLOT VOTING INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORM

Resident and Non-Resident Property Electors who are unable to make it to a voting opportunity or who expect to be out of Town during all of the voting opportunities may apply for a Mail Ballot Voting Package. The Mail Ballot Voting Package contains all of the information and materials (except postage) that you need in order to submit your ballot in person, by mail or by courier.

For this municipal by-election, ALL eligible electors have the opportunity to cast their vote by mail ballot. **In order to be eligible to vote by mail, electors must be registered to vote with the Town of Comox (NOTE: you must be registered by 4:30 pm October 5, 2021 in order to be eligible to vote by mail).**

Mail Ballot Voting Application Process:

1. Ensure that you are registered to vote. If you are unsure, contact the Chief Election Officer or the Deputy Chief Election Officer at Comox Town Hall at 250.339.2202 or elections@comox.ca.
2. Complete the Mail Ballot Voting Application Form on the reverse of this sheet. Note that each elector must complete their own application.
3. Return the completed Application Form to Town Hall, either in person, by mail, email, or fax.

NOTE: if you are or will be out of Town and need the Mail Ballot Voting Package to be mailed to you, please ensure that we receive your application no later than **Friday, November 5, 2021** in order to ideally provide sufficient time for you to receive and return your package.

If your application is accepted, please note:

- All mail ballot packages are sent out by Canada Post standard mail service.
- Mail ballot packages are expected to be available the second week of November, following our receipt of the ballots. Packages can either be mailed to you or picked up at Town Hall.
- If you will be outside of Canada between November 5 and November 27, 2021, we recommend that you designate someone to pick up your mail ballot package on your behalf and express post it to your out-of-country location (please ensure that this person is noted on your application form).
- You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is **received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 pm on general voting day, Saturday, November 27, 2021**. This can be done by ensuring delivery to either: (Note: Mail ballots received after this deadline will not be counted)
