### **AUTOMATED CURBSIDE COLLECTION CARTS**

TAKE TO CURBSIDE BY 8AM

THE CART SIZE AND MAX WEIGHT LIMIT IS LISTED ON THE LID: ALLOW FOR 1 METRE (3FT) OF CLEARANCE AROUND ALL CARTS.

360L = 332.5lbs / 240L = 227.5lbs / 120L = 122.5lbs

### **Organics** (Weekly collection)

**GREEN LID CART** 

Both food and yard waste can be included in the green automated collection cart. Please ensure all the material is kept inside the cart with the lid completely closed. If you choose to line your organics cart, use paper such as a yard waste bag, newspaper, or soiled pizza box. For a detailed listing of acceptable organic items, visit comox.ca/organicsbrochure

#### NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- Biodegradable or compostable plastics
- Oils/grease
- Sod and soil
- Personal hygiene items Rocks or stumps
- Stickers
- Metal or Pet waste and diapers synthetic materials

- Leaves
  - Branches cut up to fit within your cart with the lid completely closed
  - Grass clippings

**ACCEPTABLE:** 

- Kitchen waste
- Flowers
- Plants
- Tree or hedge pruning

### **Recycling** (Bi-weekly Collection)

**BLUE LID CART** 

Place all items loose in the cart, no need to bag or stack. Dry paper only. Empty and rinse containers. Remove any tape, string, ribbon or other contaminants.

Materials placed in plastic bags will not be accepted.

#### **NOT ACCEPTED:** TAKE TO THE RECYCLE DEPOTS

- Glass (bottles and jars)
- Foam packaging
- Overwrap & bags
- Flexible packaging

#### PAPER PACKAGING AND CARDBOARD:

- Cardboard boxes (broken down and placed O Multi-layered paper bags to fit inside the cart)
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper bags
- Clean cartons
- Household paper
  - (for flour, sugar, etc.)
  - Clean paper take-out packaging and utensils

#### **ACCEPTABLE:**

#### **PAPER:**

- Paper plates, bowls, cups (with thin plastic lining)
- Paper party décor (including paper decorations, signs, hats, tablecloths and pinatas)
- Newspaper, inserts, flyers
- Shredded paper (contained in a paper bag or box such as a cereal or shoe box)
- Magazines, catalogues, yellow pages, white pages, and other directories (no books, please donate)
- Writing and home office paper, paper envelopes, notepads
- Paper gift wrap and greeting cards (musical greeting cards must go to a depot with e-waste)

#### **PLASTIC:**

- Single-use plastic items: plates, bowls, cups, straws, cutlery, stir sticks, coffee/tea pods
- Plastic dental floss care and tape dispensers
- Plastic food storage containers
- Plastic disposable clothes hangers
- Plastic plant pots and seeding trays
- Plastic bottles jars and jugs
- Plastic trays and clamshells

#### METAL:

- Thin gauge metal storage tins
- Food tins, cans and lids
- Aluminum foil wrap
- Aluminum take-out containers, pie plates, baking dishes
- Empty aerosol cans

### Garbage/Landfill (Bi-weekly Collection)

**BLACK LID CART** 

All garbage needs to be bagged. No loose items in cart. Use either one large, or multiple smaller bags, tied closed to prevent items from falling onto the street when the cart is being emptied.


