If you're passionate about fostering fun experiences and making memories while enjoying time outside, we may have the perfect summer job for you!

Successful candidates will be available to work the dates of the respective positions, have experience working with children, and will demonstrate excellent customer service and communication skills. You must be responsible, possess valid and current Emergency or Community First Aid/CPR C & AED certification, and be able to submit a clear criminal record check. Candidates should also have strong creative problem-solving and leadership skills. Those interested in working at the Hands On Farm should have experience and a passion for working with and caring for farm animals of all sizes.

Summer Day Camp Positions Available:

- Summer Day Camp Leaders – 2 positions
 - 35 - 40 hours per week, Monday - Friday
 - Working with children 3 - 11 years
 - Approximate dates are June 23 - August 30
 - Wage: \$22/hour

- Summer Day Camp: Support Leaders – 1-2 positions
 - Additional support staff to Summer Camp Leaders. Individuals 16 years of age and up are welcome to apply.
 - 35 - 40 hours per week, Monday - Friday
 - Working with children 3 - 11 years
 - Approximate dates are June 23 - August 30
 - Wage: \$19-20/hour

Hands on Farm Positions Available:
